KEY NOTE SPEAKER MICHAEL MURPHY

Michael Murphy, the executive director of the International Catholic Stewardship Council, has introduced the spirituality of Christian stewardship to dioceses in North America, Asia, and Central and South America. He has also addressed bishops' conferences in the United States, the Philippines, Latin America and the Caribbean. Mr. Murphy served as director of stewardship and development for the Archdiocese of Detroit. He developed a manual for introducing stewardship to parish communities. *Called by Christ, Gifted by the Spirit*, anticipating its third edition, has been used extensively in many parishes and dioceses. Currently, Mr. Murphy is working on a book that examines the theology of stewardship in the writings of St. Luke.

He is the author of many academic articles on organizational culture, and two books meant for a wider audience, *The Thriving Organization* and *A Friday Filled With Joy*. **Space for the workshop is limited. Only those only those who are sure they will be able to participate should RSVP. If you are unavailable, there will be more workshops offered in the future.*


