

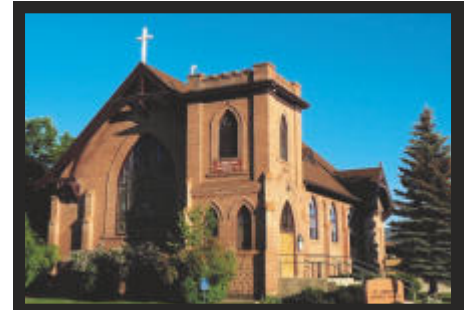

THE SHORTEST DISTANCE IS BETWEEN

In 1881, God gave a small group of miners a mission to bring to the mountains of Park City the world's greatest treasure: the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, the Eucharist, and the Faith and Charity that flows from it.

Today that mission has spread from the streets of Old Town Park City, to the meadows of White Pine Canyon, to the Heber Valley. As your pastor, I am excited to continue that mission and write the next chapter of St. Mary's story with you. To evangelize, to catechize, to give back in Charity and enrich our community through the Catholic Faith. To bring all the treasure of Jesus Christ, for the salvation of souls, and the Greater Glory of God.

On Friday, Fr. Rodel celebrated his anniversary of ordination. Below are his words reflecting on being a priest:

The Instrument of God

Priesthood is a gift from God for his people. The people who are stubborn, who always forget, who often turns away and reject God, are always in the heart of God. God's love for people is unchanging. And God always find a way to reach one of us especially those who are astray.

In every Sacrament I perform, I experience that God is always present with us.

In the Sacrament of Healing, the God who healed then is the same God who heals today.

One time I visited a sick person, the moment I entered their home she requested for me to leave. I felt ashamed. But the family urged me to stay and continue to pray for their loved one. I lost my concentration during that time because of the embarrassment; I thought of ending the prayer immediately and leave their house.

When I was near the part of the anointing of the Holy Oil, just before I touched her forehead, tears suddenly fell down her face. And when I was done with the Sacrament, the sick person embraced and thanked me after.

Here I witnessed that our God never gives up for his people. In this mysterious Sacrament people receive the healing of body and soul.

Once during my prayer, a sick person whom I haven't visited for a long time came into my mind. I tried not to think about the person because I already gave the sacrament to her and that means I am no longer responsible and I have already asked the communion distributor to visit the person and give the Holy Communion.

But the voice of the Lord was loud in my conscience that is why I visited the person again. I learned from that person that she was always longing and praying to receive Holy Communion. At the same time, I also learned that the communion distributor have forgotten to visit her.

Indeed, our God is the God of love. He uses the priests so that people may KNOW, FEEL and EXPERIENCE that God is always in our midst.

All baptized Christians share in this ministry through physical care, prayer, pastoral visits to bring Holy Communion, and by celebrating the Sacraments of the Sick. This ministry is carried out by our parish priests, deacons and a select group of parishioners specifically trained for Pastoral Care.

It is the responsibility of family and friends to contact the church, who will then set-up Pastoral Care for the person in need. The Privacy Act prohibits medical institutions from automatically contacting churches when someone checks in, you must specifically ask that a minister be contacted or contact the church yourself. 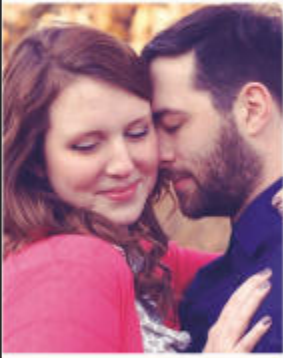

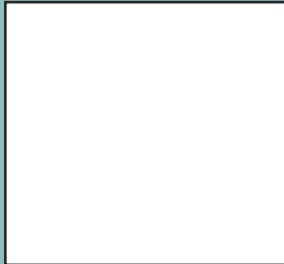

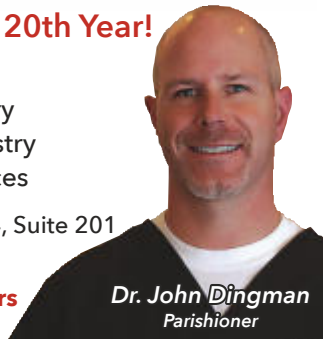
