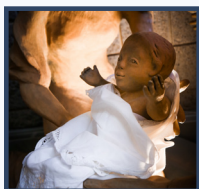

A former classmate of Fr. Gray, Fr. Joseph Hamilton is an adjunct professor of sacred theology at the Pontifical University of St. Thomas (Angelicum) in Rome. His areas of research

include the philosophic and soteriological aspects of pneumatology, angelology and of demonology. He is also a chaplain of the Order of St. John, and serves as George Cardinal Pell's secretary.

PRESERVE ST. MARY'S OLD TOWN CAMPUS

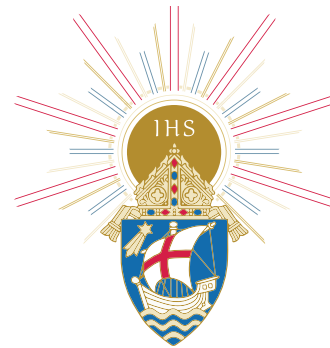


St. Mary's Old Town Chapel in historic Park City is Utah's oldest Catholic Church.

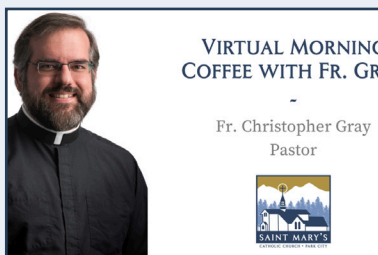

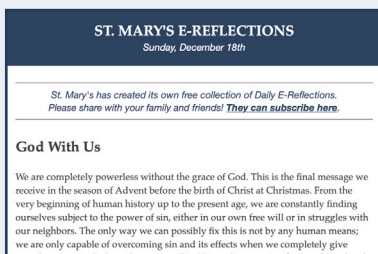
