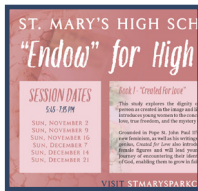

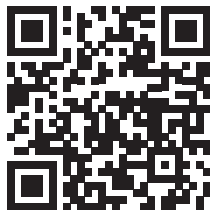
PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING AFTER MASS
