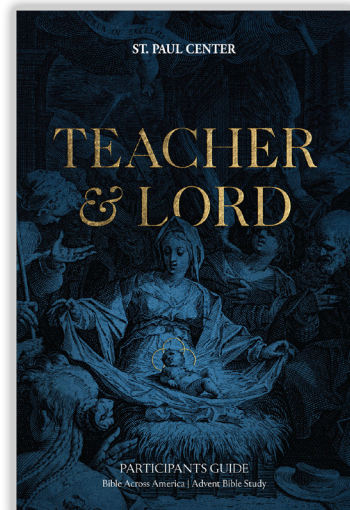



*This year, we celebrate the 100th anniversary of the Solemnity of Christ the King of the Universe, yes, of the Universe. 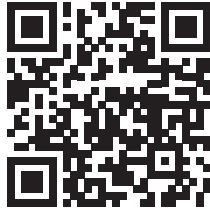
## PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING AFTER MASS
