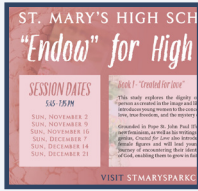

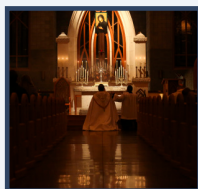

Requirements:

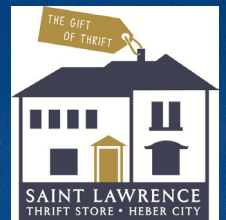
- *Be a member of St. Mary's Parish or St. Lawrence Mission*
