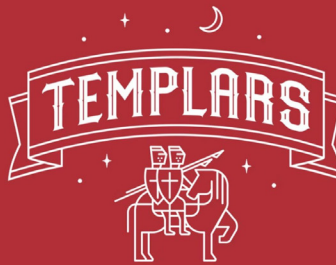

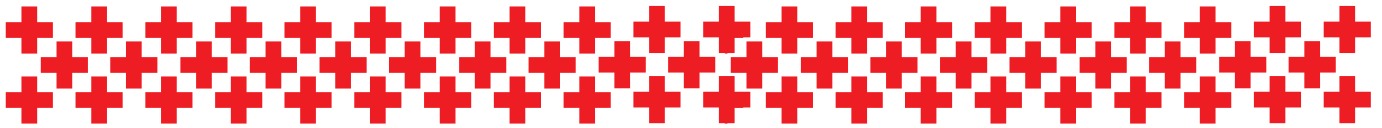
A CALLING FOR ALL HIGH SCHOOL MEN
