# FINDING JOY

## A MESSAGE FROM YOUR PASTOR

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Christ is risen! He is truly risen!

One of the most beautiful, and often unnoticed, truths about Easter is this: **Joy was not immediately recognized. It was discovered.**

On Easter morning, no one began with joy. Mary Magdalene came weeping. The disciples were hiding in fear. The two disciples on the road to Emmaus were walking away in disappointment. Joy did not begin as joy. It began as confusion, sorrow, and even doubt. And yet, slowly, quietly, something changed. A voice calls a name: “*Mary.*” Bread is broken. Scriptures are opened. A presence is felt. And suddenly... sorrow turns into joy. The Gospel tells us: “*Then the disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord.*” (John 20:20) This is the journey of Easter.

Joy is not the absence of suffering. Joy is the discovery that Christ is present, even within it. In our lives, we often look for joy in the wrong places, in success, in control, in things going our way. But Easter teaches us: Joy is not found in perfect circumstances. It is found in the presence of the Risen Christ.

St. Thomas Aquinas reminds us: “**Joy is caused by love.**” And where Christ is present, love is present, and therefore joy is possible. This means something very important: *You do not have to wait for everything in your life to be resolved before you can have joy.* Even in your struggles, even in your wounds, even in your unanswered questions, Christ is there. And where He is, joy can begin. This Easter, do not search for joy as something far away. Instead, look for Him. In the Eucharist. In prayer. In His Word. In the quiet moments of your life. Because when you find Him, you will find joy.

As you participate in the Holy Mass, if you desire, you can use this prayer:

*Lord Jesus Christ, You are risen and alive, too often, I search for joy in the wrong places. Help me to find You. Open my heart to Your presence. Fill me with the joy that only You can give. And teach me to remain in You always. Amen.*

May the Risen Lord fill your hearts with a deep and lasting joy, the joy that no one can take away.
