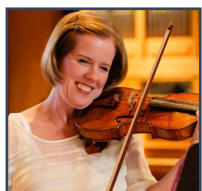

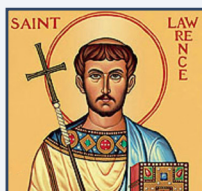

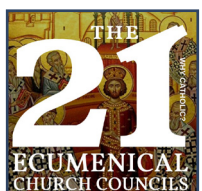

We will be giving away Brown Scapulars at Mass on Thursday, July 16th

Why Wear the Brown Scapular?

The Brown Scapular is one of the Church's oldest and most treasured sacramentals. It is not a lucky charm or a magical object, but a visible sign of our desire to follow Jesus more closely with the help of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

According to Carmelite tradition, the Blessed Virgin Mary entrusted the Brown Scapular to St. Simon Stock and promised her special maternal protection to those who faithfully wear it. The Church teaches that this promise is not an automatic guarantee of heaven, but an invitation to live a life of faith, prayer, and fidelity to Christ under Mary's loving care.

If You Wear the Brown Scapular...

1. Wear it with faith, not superstition.
2. Pray every day, especially to Our Lady (the Rosary is highly encouraged).
3. Receive the Sacraments regularly, especially the Holy Eucharist and Reconciliation.
4. Imitate Mary's virtues, her humility, purity, obedience, and love for God.
5. Live as a faithful disciple of Jesus each day.

The Brown Scapular reminds us that we belong to Christ, and that Mary, our Mother, lovingly accompanies us on the journey to heaven. Mary always leads us to her Son."
