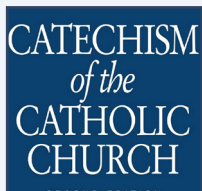

This coming Monday, July 6, we celebrate the Feast of Saint Maria Goretti, one of the youngest saints of the Church. At just eleven years old, she gave her life rather than betray her love for Christ, and before she died, she forgave the man who attacked her. She is the patron saint of youth, purity, forgiveness, victims of abuse, and those seeking healing and reconciliation.

Our parish is blessed to have a relic of Saint Maria Goretti. Following the conclusion of Mass on Monday, everyone is invited to come forward to venerate her relic and ask for her powerful intercession for yourselves, your children, your grandchildren, and all our families.

As you come forward, you may wish to pray:

"Saint Maria Goretti, obtain for me a pure heart, the courage to follow Christ faithfully, the grace to forgive those who have hurt me, and God's protection over our children, young people, and families. Saint Maria Goretti, pray for us. Amen."
