THE FIRST “NOEL”

ST. MARY’S NEW PAROCHIAL VICAR

A holy family, late night and early morning vigils, time with loved ones, and seeing the humanity of Jesus are all pretty typical themes that are evoked during Christmas time. And while the yuletide season hasn’t come yet, Saint Mary’s new parochial vicar, Fr. Noel Ancheta, has.

Raised in the Philippines as a child, Fr. Noel would eventually begin to feel a call to the priesthood, something he credits to frequent family devotions and an environment conducive to his faith.

“One of my aunts was blind,” Fr. Noel said. “She would wake up at 4 o’clock just to pray the rosary and all of us, the nephews and nieces and her siblings were included in the rosary.”

Fr. Noel was then ordained a priest in 1988. Around 2016, he followed some of his family to Phoenix. After about three years, however, the COVID-19 pandemic hit and much of the available funding for paying the salary of priests was severely reduced and the diocese recommended finding another place to be a priest.

“I immediately thought of Bishop Solis, who was here in Salt Lake City,” Fr. Noel said.

After contacting Bishop Solis, Fr. Noel was invited in 2020 and would be assigned to be an on-call chaplain at three hospitals around the Salt Lake area for a couple of years.

“After the two-year stint at the hospital, I told the bishop, ‘I want a parish,’” he said. “I want to work in a parish.”

Now assigned as the parochial vicar to St. Mary’s and St. Lawrence, Fr. Noel plans to use his experience as a hospital chaplain to improve his pastoral ministry.

“It broadens my horizons, especially those people who are cared for less: the sick, the infirm, and the disabled,” Fr. Noel said.

Thanks to his time around the poor, Fr. Noel will try to see Christ in present in the humanity of everyone, especially of those in need.

“To be honest, it really brings me closer to Christ because my ministry there, seeing those sick, I reminded myself of seeing the person of Jesus in the sick,” he said.

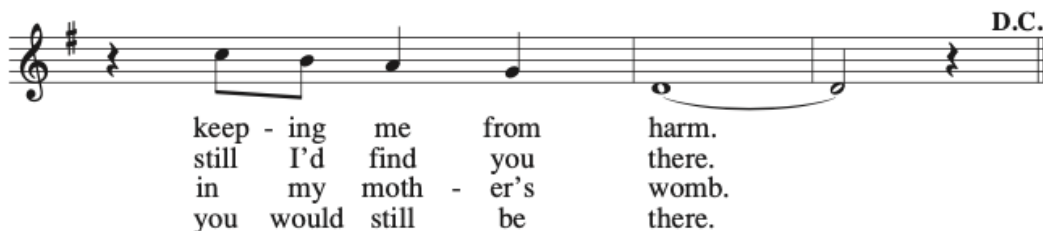
