In the midst of the Babylonian Exile, with their Temple destroyed and their spirit crushed, the ancient Jews possess nothing but the psalms with which to pray to God. God hears the prayer of His people during their trial by water and fire and responds to them not simply with one of the most beautiful oracles of salvation the prophets have ever uttered, but one in which He weaves a tapestry from the very prayers of His people.

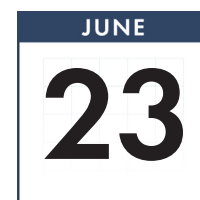


WORLD MEETING OF FAMILIES HOLY HOUR


