As we celebrate the coming of Jesus, who entered our world in the flesh, fully God and fully man, on this day over 2000 years ago, **I invite you into a deeper understanding of and love for Christ's real presence in the Eucharist, His actual body and blood, which will be consecrated at this Mass, Christ's Mass, Christmas.**

The Eucharist is the Source and Summit of the Christian Life. The reason why we gather together this

Christmas and every Sunday is not just for the community, or family tradition, or for the spiritual lessons we might learn in the homilies. These things are good, great, and necessary. But the reason why we are able to gather in the first place is the Eucharist. Through the Eucharist we come into communion with "Christ the King, whom shepherds guard and angels . . . the babe, the son of Mary."

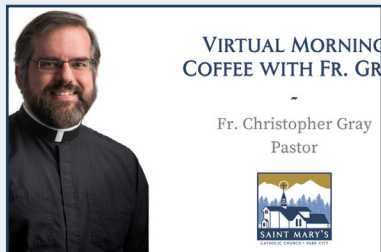

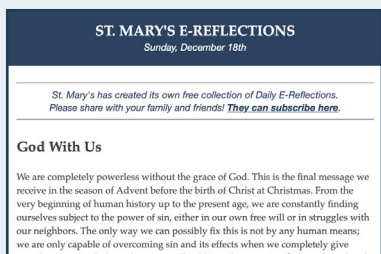

PRESERVE ST. MARY'S OLD TOWN CAMPUS

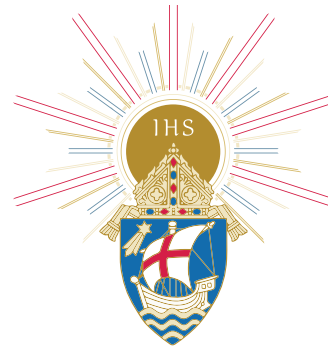


St. Mary's Old Town Chapel in historic Park City is Utah's oldest Catholic Church.

Built in 1884, the Old Town Chapel is Utah's Oldest Catholic Church and served as St. Mary's primary Church until 1997. Open daily for all to visit, pray at, and worship, the Chapel is a special and revered establishment of the Old Town Community, a precious reminder of our roots, and a landmark of our town. Additionally, the Chapel hall is utilized weekly for St. Mary's community events, our food bank, and more.

The parking lot for the Old Town Campus (which also is home to our St. Lawrence Thrift Store Donation Center) will need to be completely renovated in the new year. 


