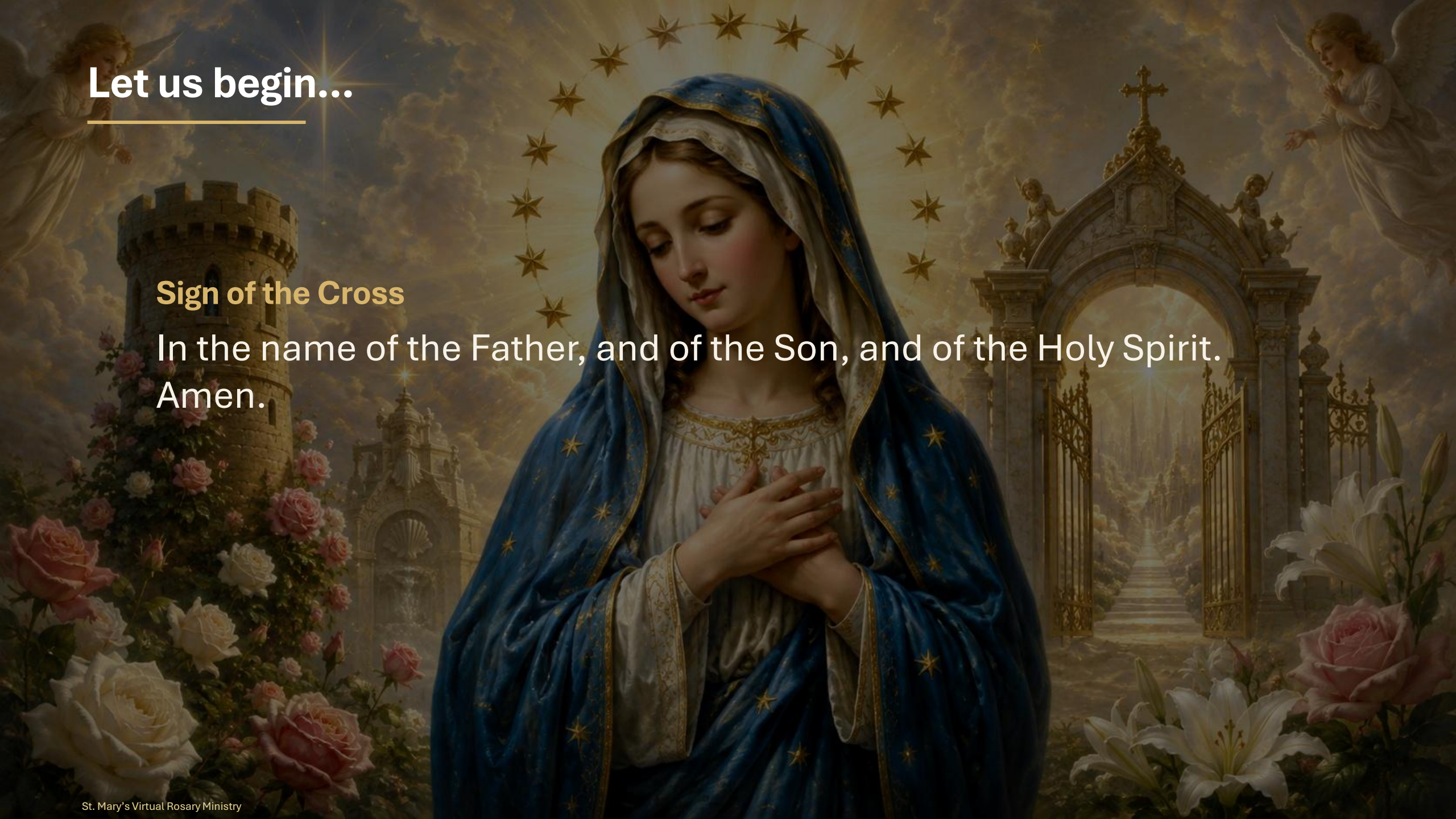

Today we gather online to pray the Holy Rosary in a spirit of faith, unity, and hope.

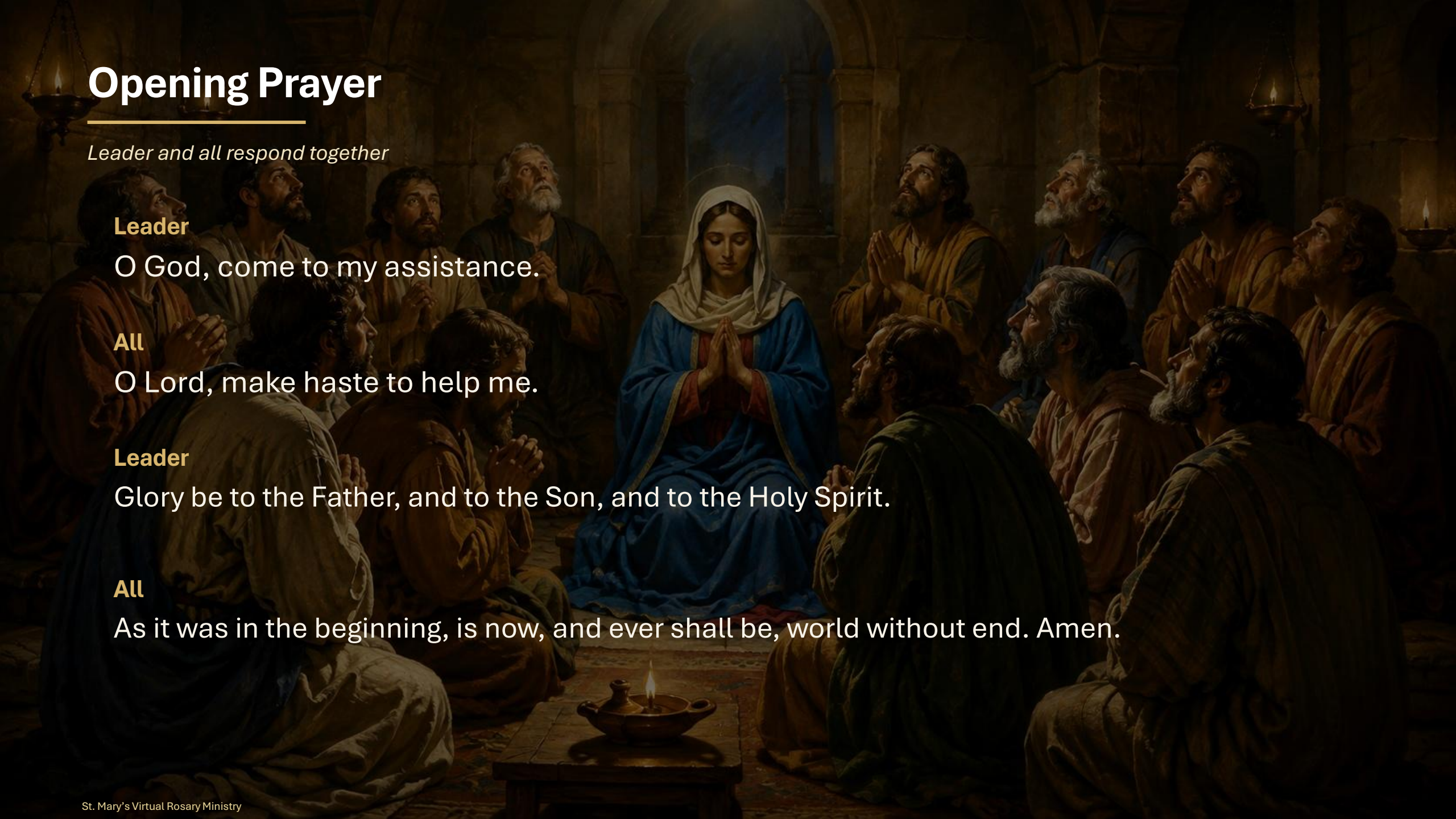
