The florid interplay of *a cappella* voices in Josquin de Prez' *Missa Pange Lingua*, first composed in Europe around 1500, still resonates through modern cathedrals, chapels, and concert halls today. At the core of this is the body of *plainchant*, the liturgical texts and melodies of the Catholic Church that continue to mark important moments in the yearly cycles of the church.

Learn how to listen to and comprehend the meaning of this music that ultimately formed an integral part of the liturgy that continues to this day.

Come hear professors Dr. Jane Hatter and Dr. Christopher LeCluyse speak on the historical development and meaning of music throughout Christian worship.

Confession will be heard beforehand in the church from 4:30 - 6:30 PM. Food and drinks will be provided and all are invited to attend!

Also come to the 3 PM Latin Mass on Sunday, February 26, to hear the professors provide the music during the liturgy!

FINANCIAL SUMMARY AND POSITION FOR THE FIRST HALF OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDED ON 12/31/2022

The first half of the fiscal year brought growth to the Mission not seen since before the pandemic. Our annual Fall Festival brought everyone together for a county-wide community event, being the most attended in the past few years. The Fall Festival brought in a total of \$13,381 to the building fund due to the generosity of our parishioners and donations from local businesses. This amount exceeds numbers from years prior, even those before the pandemic.

General offertory remains sustainable at \$62,500, on track with projections. So far, this year, we have received \$97,000 in total income. At \$4,800, the Christmas offertory doubled from prior years. The church was overflowing for Christmas Masses, with visitors and the continued growth of newcomers.

With the increase in offertory giving, the Mission has been able to make some minor improvements along with continuing to plan for more major ones. Expenditures for the Mission for this year currently sit at \$ 77,000. Comparing income to expense, the Mission has gained \$19,000 thanks to your generosity.

This year is also the closest we have been in more recent years to reaching our Diocesan Development Drive quota of \$12,500 with a shortfall of just \$1,200.

Expenditures include working towards providing more resources for our religious education program to better support the program and our families. This year we were able to purchase new books for each student, following the same curriculum as at St. Mary's. A major advantage of this was a way to better synchronize information for families who have children who might attend both from the overflowing registration numbers in each program. Though we are always in need of more volunteers to help make classes more manageable, through your continued generosity, the Mission was able to hire an additional person to assist the Director of Religious Education, especially to better serve the Hispanic population in our community. Other improvements included hiring snow removal services and installing a better phone system.

For the most recent updates on offertory information please visit the St. Lawrence website under the financial updates tab. The website can be accessed at any time from anywhere, enabling us to provide the most accurate and transparent way to keep data updated as well as keep better track of other historical data. The graphs include both monthly physical and online offertory numbers, especially important as our books close on a monthly basis not weekly. Thank you for your continued support and generosity! We are excited to see what more growth the Lord will bring for the rest of this year! God bless you and thank you!

RESUMEN FINANCIERO Y POSICIÓN DE LA PRIMERA MITAD DEL EJERCICIO TERMINADO EL 31/12/2022

La primera mitad del año fiscal trajo un crecimiento a la Misión que no se había visto desde antes de la pandemia. Nuestro Festival de Otoño anual reunió a todos para un evento comunitario en todo el condado, siendo el más concurrido en los últimos años. El Festival de Otoño aportó un total de \$13,381 al fondo de construcción gracias a la generosidad de nuestros feligreses y las donaciones de las empresas locales. Esta cantidad supera las cifras del año anterior, incluso antes de la pandemia.

El ofertorio general se mantiene sostenible en \$62,500, en línea con las proyecciones. Hasta ahora, este año, hemos recibido \$97,000 en ingresos totales. A \$4,800, el ofertorio de Navidad se duplicó con respecto a años anteriores. La iglesia estaba repleta de misas navideñas, con visitantes y el continuo crecimiento de los recién llegados.

Con el aumento en la entrega de ofrendas, la Misión ha podido hacer algunas mejoras menores y continuar planificando otras más importantes. Los gastos de la Misión para este año ascienden actualmente a \$77,000. Comparando los ingresos con los gastos, la Misión ha ganado \$19,000 gracias a su generosidad.

Este año también es el más cercano que hemos estado en años más recientes de alcanzar nuestra cuota de la Impulsión de Desarrollo Diocesano de \$12,500 con un déficit de solo \$1,200.

Los gastos incluyen trabajar para proporcionar más recursos para nuestro programa de educación religiosa para apoyar mejor el programa y nuestras familias. Este año pudimos comprar libros nuevos para cada estudiante, siguiendo el mismo plan de estudios que en St. Mary's. Una gran ventaja de esto fue una forma de sincronizar mejor la información para las familias que tienen niños que podrían asistir a ambos desde los números de registro desbordados en cada programa. Aunque siempre necesitamos más voluntarios para ayudar a que las clases sean más manejables, gracias a su generosidad continua, la Misión pudo contratar una persona adicional para ayudar al Director de Educación Religiosa, especialmente para servir mejor a la población hispana de nuestra comunidad. Otras mejoras incluyeron la contratación de servicios de remover nieve y la instalación de un mejor sistema telefónico.
